

How to Blurt: 5 Steps

Read this side first. Then flip over and fill the page.

1

Pick a topic

Choose one specific topic from your specification, not a whole subject. Write it in the box on the other side.

2

Blurt

Close your books. Write down everything you remember about the topic on the blurring page. Set a timer if that helps, but there's no set limit. Keep going until nothing else comes out.

Don't stop to check facts. Just get it all out first.

3

Mark it up (different colour pen)

Switch to a different coloured pen. Circle or underline anything you're unsure of, questions that come to mind, and any gaps you notice.

4

Check & add

Now open your textbook and notes. Fill in the gaps you marked, correct any mistakes, and add missing detail, still on the same page.

5

Compose your final answer

Check trusted resources (spec, mark scheme, revision guide) for what a strong answer should include, then write a clear, complete version of your answer.
